## MLA 9th Edition

## Reference Guide for Creating source cards

In April 2021, the Modern Language Association updated their citation format. The ninth edition brings few changes –students will continue look for the nine core elements to cite a source correctly. \*\*Look for all nine elements when citing a source, but make note that not all nine will be found with every source. If you don't find an element, move on to the next.

Below are some samples of different sources in the MLA 9<sup>th</sup> edition format. By the label, the number in parenthesis refers to element chart on the right.
