Use Last Name, First Name of video creator or Username of Creator.

The Works Cited page is a **separate** sheet placed after the last page of your essay. **(Ctrl+enter)** Include **full URLs** to assist the reader in locating the online source. Use a standard font style such as **Times New Roman 12 pt.** for formal essays.
